


HOW WAS THIS STATUETTE IDENTIFIED?

Mainly on the internet : consultation of online

sales catalogues is a good way to find artefacts.

WHAT HAPPENED?


During the winter 1999-2000, marble sculptures were stolen directly from the american archaeological storehouse in Cyrene. The thieves have never been identified, unlike the stolen sculptures: statuette 74-423 is one of them.

WHY IS THIS STATUETTE A GOOD EXAMPLE?

It illustrates on its own several characteristics of illicit traffick :

- It came from a theft and from a country in conflict
- It appears on the legal antiquities market in Europe and in the USA
- On the sales announcements its provenance is falsified
- Its original appearance has been changed : the traffickers added a head!
